You will note that as a 3rd Quarter Report not all Income and Expenses are at 75% of the Budgeted amounts for the Fiscal Year. Below is a break out of the significant items included in the income and expenses:

*Extraordinary Income is comprised of bequests, a surplus from the Lenten Appeal, and the very generous assistance of the Vietnamese Community, who have made a 50% payment as of the end of April on their annual donation of \$20,000 to the Operating Budget.

** Non-Operating Income is withdraws from savings to cover unexpected projects, works of charity, and the budget shortfall.

^Local Ministerial Subsidies is the Parish Catholic School Assessment and our support of the Catholic Priest Chaplain at the Harrisburg Hospitals.

^^Other Expenditures include Local Property Taxes, Local Municipal Fees, Property Insurance, Parish Programs, Building Improvements and Deposits to Savings (St. Jude Fund).
^^New Furnace Debt payment is higher due to a restricted donation toward the principal.

Dear Parishioners,

As we prepare to begin the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year, I present to you the Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish proposed budget. In consultation with the Parish Finance Council and the Diocese of Harrisburg, this budget has been submitted for the upcoming year, beginning on July 1, 2017. As you will clearly see we have proposed, once again, a deficit budget. Given that our current budget year will deplete all of Parish Savings, we must generate income and reduce expenses as we respond to our precarious financial situation. Below you will see a summary form of our budgeted income and expenses, with a few notes to describe the categories.

Sadly, as we are well aware, a deficit budget due to inadequate Sunday Weekly Offering is not unexpected. Further, it has been many years since Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish has had a proposed budget that did not depend upon Parish Savings, the Lenten Appeal surplus, bequests, estate gifts, and other extraordinary income to offset the annual operating expenses. This concern about our Sunday Weekly Offering is a particularly serious issue, since we have no Parish Savings.

Obviously, the proposed OLBS 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Budget is very concerning and sobering. The anticipated deficit of **\$38,541** is a large amount given that our current income projections do not meet annual expenses. Just as it is in any business, organization, or household, a parish that cannot pay its own bills cannot expect to survive as a Parish for long.

Thank you for your review of our proposed 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Budget.


